APRIL is the fourth month of the year in the Gregorian Calendar and one of four with the length of 30 days. April was originally the second month of the Roman calendar, before January and February were added by King Numa Pompilius about 700 BC. It became the fourth month of the calendar year (the year when twelve months are displayed in order) during the time of the decemvirs about 450 BC, when it also was given 29 days. The Julian calendar reform of 46 BC gave April 30 days, effective in 45 BC.

Wars that started/ended in April include:

- The American Revolution (started with Paul Revere's Ride: April 18-19, 1775.
- The American Civil War (started April 1861, ended April 1865 - thus "Across Five Aprils")
- The Bosnian War began in the first days of April, 1992.
- The Twandan Genocide began in April, 1994.

Other events that have occurred in the month of April:

- President Abraham Lincoln's assassination (April 14, 1865.
- The 1906 San Francisco Earthquake (April 18, 1906)
- The sinking of the RMS *Titanic* (April 14-15, 1912)

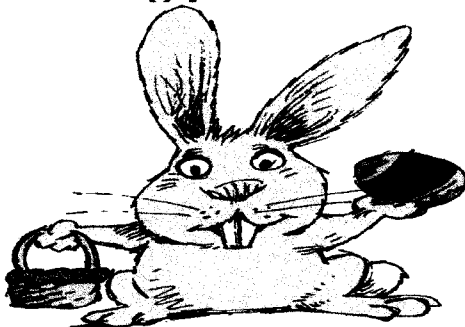

NEW STREET SIGNS

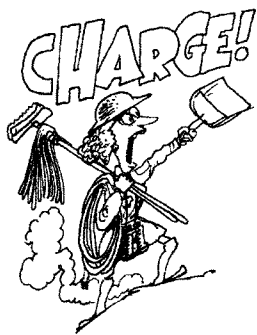

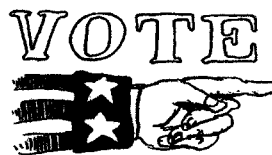
PROPERTY OWNER'S DISPOSAL SITE

PLEASE NOTE!!

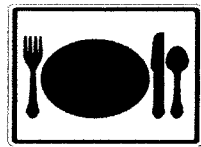

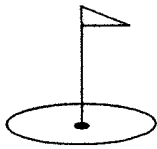

DEER TRACE GOLF COMMITTEE MEETING - March 5, 2007

The March meeting was called to order by President, Don Spitzenberger. Golf Course Superintendent, Dale Moles, stated the greens on 12, 16 and 17 have been patched with sod. The greens will be much faster this summer. The putting green looks good. Dale has three (3) more bunkers to put in. He is looking for an Assistant to replace Kyle who took a new position in Wisconsin. All the water cooler stands may have to be altered or replaced because of the potential bacteria problem. The regular tee boxes will be open by the Season Opener. This year, Dale will be beautifying the course - flowers, pampas grass, trees, etc. The flag at the golf course will be moved so that it will be lighted. Dale reminded everyone to please NOT use the Nos. 5 and 9 greens for chipping and putting practice!

The following fees were approved: \$2.50 bucket; \$50.00 24-discount card; and \$60.00 36-discount card. Also approved were the changes/additions to the Deer Trace Golf Course Rules and Regulations.

An Annual Trail Fee applies to the individual POA member (not the cart).

Pam McCoy, General Manager, stated that the Board approved a Reciprocal Agreement with Sugar Valley Lakes. With a Reciprocal Card (provided by the POA office), a POA Member can golf at Sugar Valley at Sugar Valley's member rates, and vice versa.

- * Not spayed or neutered -- \$8
- * Three or more dogs kennel fee -- \$25
- * Late fee after May 1st -- \$10 additional
