## GET A JOB!

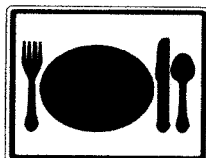
My first job was working in an orange juice factory, but I got canned -- couldn't concentrate.

The POA is providing dumpsters for Spring Clean Up. Place all items OUTSIDE bins and the Maintenance crew will sort out the items and place them in the proper bins.

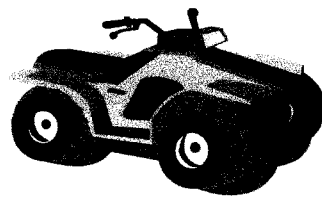

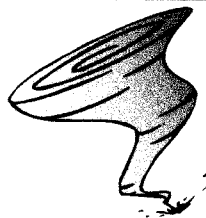

## SEVERE WEATHER PROCEDURE

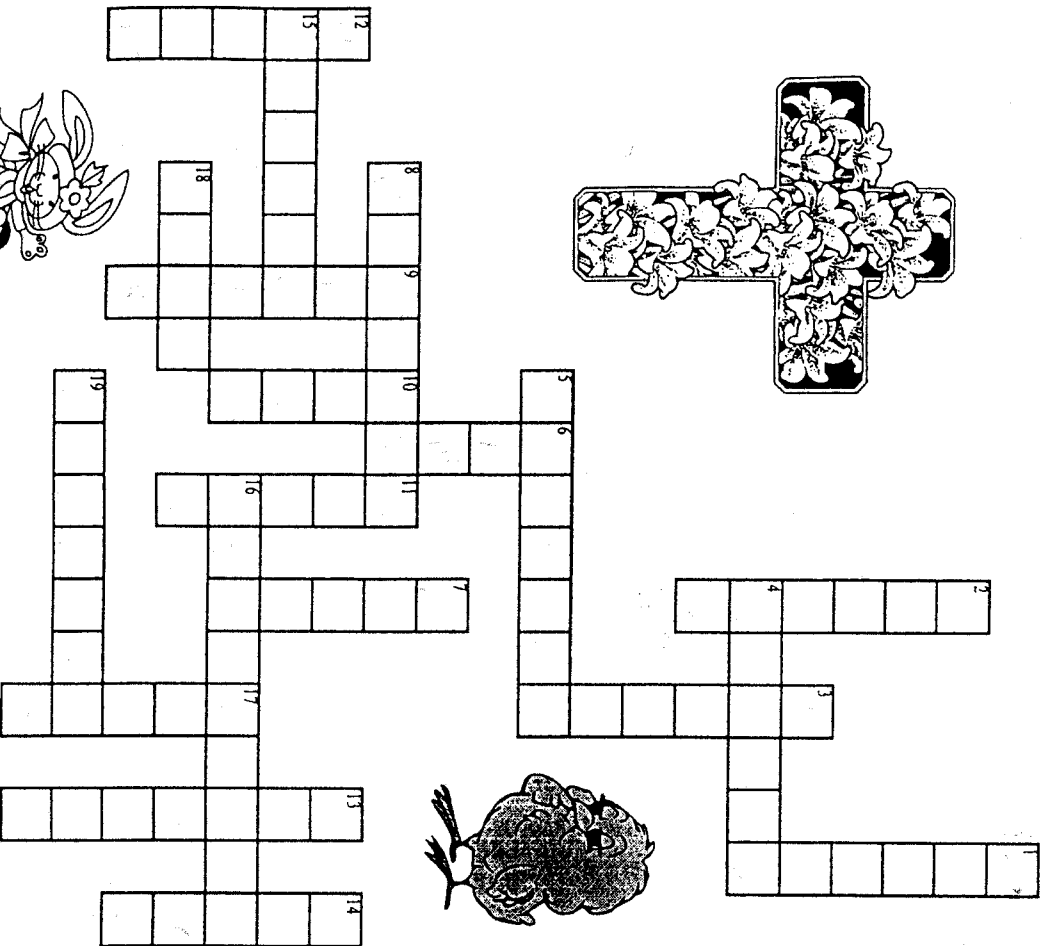
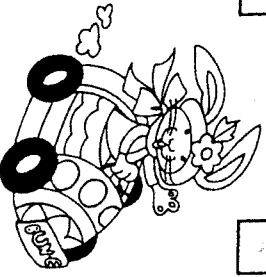
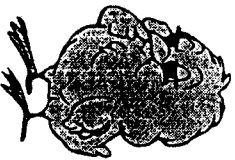
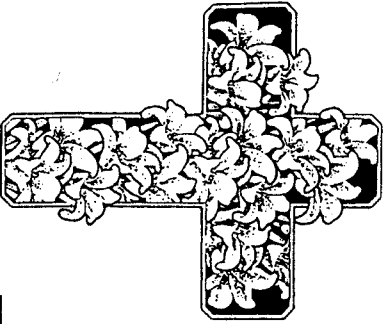
