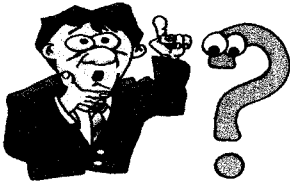


LINN VALLEY

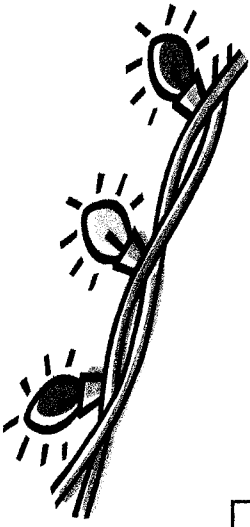

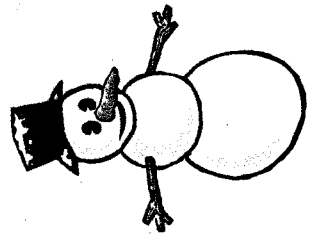
