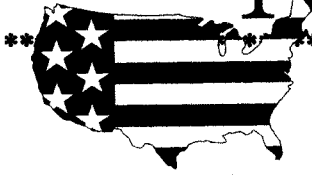

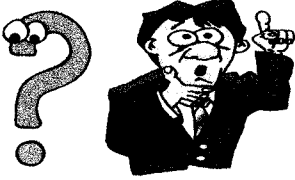

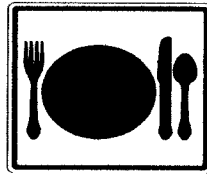

MEALS ON WHEELS

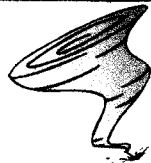
Volunteers are urgently needed to assist in delivering Meals on Wheels to Linn Valley residents.

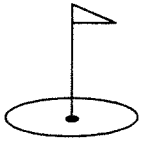


SEVERE WEATHER PLANS
